Merit Based Scholarships

\$1,000-\$3,000 GHS Merit Scholarships: Students in grades 3-12 who excel in the following areas are encouraged to apply for GHS Merit Scholarships: Academics, Arts, Athletics, or Citizenship.

Nekwan Sprauve Memorial Scholarship: This fund was created in memory of Nekwan “Neko” Sprauve, a GHS 9th grade student who passed away in 2010. Students who excel in the arts, athletics or possess Neko’s positive outlook are encouraged to apply for this Scholarship.

Trayser Scholarship: This fund was inspired by the generosity and leadership of Fred Trayser, who has served as President of the Board as well as facilitated the construction of the Upper Campus. Students who exhibit generosity towards others, leadership, and a strong work ethic are encouraged to apply for this scholarship.

Financial Need-Based Scholarships

Kids First! Scholarships: These \$3,000 scholarships are renewable and are designed for incoming Preschool through 2nd grade students. Twenty (20) scholarships are made possible by an Early Learning Grant from Kids First!, Inc. and a generous matching donor.

Miss Alice O’Connor Award: This one-time \$2,500 award is designed for new students at GHS in any grade and is available for 2011-2012 only. This award is funded by the Rutnik Family.

Ruby Rutnik Scholarship: In memory of Ruby Rutnik, the Rutnik family is offering one \$2,500 scholarship award to an incoming Preschool, Pre-K, or Kindergarten student.

V.I. Lottery Scholarships: Virgin Islands Lottery has created three (3) \$750 awards for GHS high school students who plan to attend college, have lived in the Virgin Islands for at least 5 years, and have demonstrated financial need.

Tuition assistance is also available and is distributed based on financial need on a first-come, first-served basis. All students requesting tuition assistance and need-based scholarships must complete the FACTS Aid Application. Please contact the Business Office for more information.
